

PHY385 Practicals Presentations to your Peers

In today's Practical, all *N* pods will do a presentation at the white-board in front of the class. (Here *N* is the number of full pods of 3 or 4 students each.)

Your Instructor will give you a list of *N* problems, either from past tests, or from the end of chapters of your textbooks.

All pod-groups must write the answers for *all N* problems in the pod notebook for marks in this practical.

Also, your team must give a short presentation on *one* of the problems (the one with the number corresponding to your group). At least 2 of your members must speak, and you should talk at the whiteboard to the entire class. The presentation should not be more than about 5 minutes, and should convey how you got the answer to the problem.
