

# Review of Module 1

- Philosophy
  - The user is always right
- Logging out
  - `exit`
  - End of file:
    - `[Ctrl-D]`
    - `^d`
    - `C-d`
- Case sensitive
- Creating files
  - Editors
    - `pico`
    - `vi`
    - `emacs`
  - `cat > some_file`
    - Type the text, end with `[Ctrl-D]`
- Appending to a file
  - Use an editor
  - `cat >> some_file`
- Deleting a file: `rm file_name`
  - No recycle bin or un-remove command
- Change your password: `passwd`

- Copying a file: `cp from to`
  - File `to` is over-written.
- Rename or move a file: `mv from to`
  - File `to` is over-written.
- Filename and Command Completion
  - Press `Tab`
    - If unique it will be completed.
    - If not unique pressing `Tab` again shows the choices.
- Command History
  - Arrow keys for navigation.
  - Extra characters can be typed at any time.
  - `Backspace` deletes to the left of the cursor.
  - `Del` and `[Ctrl-D]` delete to the right of the cursor (line style) or under the cursor (block style).
