ViewDataset Help

The program views datasets created either by some other program or by hand by you.

When the program first starts you choose the dataset file whose contents you wish to view. The display includes:

- The title of the dataset
- The name of the datafile being shown.
- The total number of datapoints in the dataset.
- A plot of the dataset
- A table of the data in the dataset.

The table of the data includes:

- First row: a description of what the variable is.
- Second row: the name of the variable as defined in the datafile.
- Subsequent rows: the values.

You may choose to view another dataset by clicking on the **Choose Another File** button.

The plot of the data chooses a default way of displaying the data which is usually appropriate. The type of display may be changed by right clicking on the **Data** tab in the upper-right corner of the plot, choosing **Common Plots**, and selecting another type of display.

Clicking on the **Stop** button exits the program
